

LEWISBURG AREA JOINT SEWER AUTHORITY  
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
TUESDAY, APRIL 18, 2023

The regular meeting of the Lewisburg Area Joint Sewer Authority was called to order at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, by William O. Smith, Chairman of the Authority, at the College Park Treatment Plant, River Road, Lewisburg, Pennsylvania.

Present: David R. Goodhart, Philip Tharp, Greg Beauseigneur, Josh Satteson, Lawson Fetterman and Alan L. Zeigler.

Also present: Kenneth G. Potter, Solicitor, Todd M. Oberdorf, Manager, and Tiffany J. Murray, Assistant Secretary.

Upon motion by Mr. Zeigler, seconded by Mr. Tharp, and unanimously carried, the Treasurer's Report for February and March 2023 and the two (2) bills were ratified. The Investment Report for February and March 2023 were distributed. (Copies attached)

Mr. Oberdorf stated that we had a customer that refused to empty his mailbox and the Postal service was unable to deliver any mail since late October 2022. Mr. Oberdorf worked with Ken Potter and we decided to have him served by the Sheriff with notice to place a Lien. The customer was served and has paid his account in full shortly after the notice was served.

Mr. Oberdorf reported to the Board that the drive unit repair should be completed shortly if they don't run into any issues. Gear Services told Mr. Oberdorf that the problem was with two (2) gears that possibly should have been replaced by the first repair or it was missed by the previous repair shop. Mr. Oberdorf stated that in order to get the two (2) warranty from Gear Services they need to replace all the bearings and seals as well. John Green was the prior mechanic we used and he stated he never saw the worn gears. Mr. Oberdorf stated he had talked to Mr. Green about the issue and he was very unhelpful to resolve the issue, and it was out of his warranty. Mr. Oberdorf stated he was able to find a company to replace the drive unit with a in kind type, but it would have to be made from scratch and they estimated it to cost \$47,000.00 to build.

Mr. Oberdorf informed the Board that the Market Street lining project is complete, minus the T Liners for four (4) laterals. They will need to come back to install them at a later date. The estimated cost to install the four (4) T Liners is approximately \$6,000.00 apiece. Mr. Oberdorf stated that the previous motion to allow him to complete the project was not to exceed \$50,000.00, without Board approval. Mr. Oberdorf said that the cost to do the main line lining came in at \$35,168.75, so in order to complete the project he would need additional funds for the T Liners. After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Zeigler, seconded by Mr. Fetterman, and unanimously carried, to approve an additional \$10,000.00 to cover the T liners, but to exceed \$60,000.00.

Mr. Oberdorf distributed the First-Quarter Budget.

Solicitor Kenneth Potter informed the Board that he sent a letter to the owner of 31 Market Street about a down spout that was tied directly to the sewer. Solicitor Kenneth Potter stated to the owner this is violating LAJSA's rules and regulations and has to be redirected immediately. Solicitor Kenneth Potter did speak with the owner and told the owner that he is to contact the Authority when this is done.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion by Mr. Fetterman, seconded by Mr. Zeigler, and unanimously carried, the same was duly adjourned at 8:33 a.m. The next meeting of the Authority will be on Tuesday, May 16, 2023.
