

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
TUESDAY MARCH 17, 2026

The regular meeting of the Lewisburg Area Joint Sewer Authority was called to order at 8:01 a.m. on Tuesday, March 17, 2026 by Alan Zeigler, Chairman of the Authority, at the College Park Treatment Plant, River Road, Lewisburg, Pennsylvania.

Present: Rodney Hepner, David R. Goodhart, Philip Tharp, Lawson Fetterman, Greg Beauseigneur, and Scott Hahn.

Also present were: Ken Potter, Solicitor, Todd M. Oberdorf, Manager, Tacie Shimko, Assistant Secretary.

Absent: Josh Satteson.

No public comment.

A motion was made by Mr. Goodhart, seconded by Mr. Hepner, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes from January 20, 2026.

The Treasurer's Reports for January and February 2026 were distributed.

Upon motion by Mr. Hepner, seconded by Mr. Fetterman, unanimously carried to approve the Treasure's Reports for January and February 2026.

Mr. Oberdorf distributed the year end Budget.

Mr. Oberdorf distributed our monthly plant effluent data sheet. (Copy attached)

Mr. Oberdorf stated that the electricians have started with the wiring for the new generator and electric for the U.V. project. He also stated that the generator has a 26-week lead time.

Mr. Oberdorf reported that we have a broken airline in one of our aeration tanks and that it may be tricky to replace due to the media that was installed in 2010. Mr. Oberdorf stated that he is looking into pumping options but we may need to rent numerous large dumpsters to hold the media until the air line is fixed.

Mr. Oberdorf stated that he has been working on the agreements for Buffalo Township and Bucknell. The current agreements will expire on June 30, 2026. After a discussion, it was decided that there were two items that needed to be added to the new agreements. BTMSA and Bucknell needs to adopt our time of sale sewer lateral inspections and keep the well update form current with LAJSA. As an alternative to the time of sale lateral program, Solicitor Potter explained could be to require BTMSA and Bucknell to install numerous continuous monitoring points prior to entering LAJSA's lines, Solicitor Potter explained.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion by Mr. Hepner, seconded by Mr. Zeigler, and unanimously carried, the same was duly adjourned at 8:43 a.m. The next meeting of the Authority will be on Tuesday April 21, 2026.
