

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
TUESDAY MAY 19, 2026

The regular meeting of the Lewisburg Area Joint Sewer Authority was called to order at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 19, 2026 by Alan Zeigler, Chairman of the Authority, at the College Park Treatment Plant, River Road, Lewisburg, Pennsylvania.

Present: Rodney Hepner, David R. Goodhart, Philip Tharp, Lawson Fetterman, Greg Beauseigneur, Josh Satteson, Scott Hahn, and Deborah Sills.

Also present were: Ken Potter, Solicitor, Todd M. Oberdorf, Manager, Tacie Shimko, Assistant Secretary.

Absent: None.

No public comment.

A motion was made by Mr. Goodhart, seconded by Mr. Fetterman, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes from April 21, 2026.

The Treasurer's Report for April 2026 was distributed. (Copy attached)

Upon motion by Mr. Fetterman, seconded by Mr. Hepner, unanimously carried to approve the Treasure's Report for April 2026.

The Investment Report for April was also distributed. (Copy attached)

Mr. Oberdorf stated that there was a portion of a sewer main line on South Second Street he would like to have another contractor replace due to the depth of the line as well as the PA DOT ROW on Market Street. He stated this line was originally on his pipe lining list but due to its condition and size they are unable to do the lining. He also stated that he was only able to get one estimate so far to do the work. After a discussion, the Board asked Mr. Oberdorf to obtain more estimates to see if the project may fall under the bidding requirements and to keep an eye on the line just in case the condition deteriorates further and turns into an emergency situation.

Correspondence: None

Mr. Oberdorf reported to the Board that our small aeration tank walls will be in need of repairs due to the plastic media scouring the concrete. Mr. Oberdorf also stated that they will be getting a VAC truck in tomorrow to finish pumping out the tank so that we can get a better idea of the damage and what air line needs to be repaired. Mr. Oberdorf stated he looked into a different kind of media but unfortunately if we change media, it will require a PA DEP permit amendment. The Board asked Mr. Oberdorf to check with the engineer to see if a change from floating media to a fixed media may be a possibility and if it appears it would be, have Larson Design Group prepare an engineering estimate for the change including the permit change. Ms. Sills asked if a Membrane Bioreactor (MBR) would be a better fit? Mr. Oberdorf stated he would look into it but he would assume it may require another tank and area to put it and may not be cost effective.

Mr. Oberdorf distributed our monthly plant effluent data sheet. (Copy attached)

Mr. Oberdorf asked the Board if there is any interest in going to the PMAA conference this year. Mr. Satteson stated that he would be interested in going.

Mr. Oberdorf stated that the agreements with Bucknell University and Buffalo Township Sewer Authority have not been received as of now.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion by Mr. Fetterman, seconded by Mr. Satteson, and unanimously carried, the same was duly adjourned at 8:50 a.m. The next meeting of the Authority will be on Tuesday June 16, 2026.
